Outings Policy

As a childminder I like to think that I'm giving the children in my care the experience of family life. Therefore, I will be taking the children out and about to do normal everyday errands such as going to the shops, Retail Park, and post office etc. We will also have more opportunities to go out to the park and play or have a picnic. All the time we will be learning and interacting to develop all the prime areas.

I will obtain parental permission for all routine outings and provide you with all the information you need on the places we visit.

If we go somewhere for a special outing I will obtain your permission also.

When we go out I will ensure that I take everything I need with me including first aid kit, nappies and changing bag, spare clothes, mobile phone, drinks and snacks. I would also appreciate it if you could provide a rain mac and wellies for your child as we do live in Manchester after all!!

I have all the relevant emergency numbers programmed into my childminding mobile. Please see my 'Lost Child Policy' for more information.

I will plan outings to ensure all the children's safety needs are met. I have a double buggy and a buggy board as well as wrist straps to keep walking children safe. We use the car to get to groups and special days out. In the car I have three car seats which are appropriately aged for children up to four years. My car will always be insured, tax and serviced up to date.
